Remembering Sharon Wikstrom



Sharon Wikstrom spent the last 6 years of her life changing the face of Karlstad. But she died before she finished. At the meeting we will find out about her life and her many contributions. And we will learn what we need to do to preserve what she gave us, and to complete the vision.

Sharon was a volunteer. She was not paid for the time she put in, which was almost full time for more than 6 years. She was responsible for the design of the buildings, and for the beauty that was brought to them. Not only did she contribute her artistic talents, but she helped in every aspect of making it work. She painted the mural on the face of Nordisk Hemslöjd. She also helped develop the store, including bringing flowers back into Karlstad. She created the theme for Nordhem, designed the interior, and started rosemaling. But she also helped to select the equipment to make the best food. She had at least some influence on the new looks of 8 buildings in Karlstad, and inspired others.
